Budget News 2019/20

The Parish Council are now consulting on the draft Budget for 2019/20, which will be approved at the 10th January 2019 meeting at Silverdale Library, 6.30pm.

The Parish Council are looking to increase the Precept to fund 2 lollipop crossing attendants at Pepper Street and Scot Hay Road – following the announcement that Staffordshire County Council may cut the funding from September 2019 onwards. The Parish Council are also looking to reinstate the Village Handyman for up to 10 hours a week. This could see an increase of up to £5.20 per year or £0.10 per week to the Precept (based on a Band D Council tax property). The annual Precept collected in addition to the Council Tax is currently £18.92 or £0.36 per week.

Parishioners are welcome to attend any meeting of Silverdale Parish Council to voice their opinions. Please see the 2 noticeboards (by Silverdale Library and Park Site shops) or the website for meeting dates, and also the budget proposals.
