## Budget News 2020/21

The Parish Council are now consulting on the draft Budget for next year (2020/21), which will be approved on Thursday 9th January 2020 meeting at Silverdale Library, 6.30pm. Parishioners are welcome to attend any meeting of Silverdale Parish Council to voice their opinions.

The Parish Council will be looking at the Precept for next year and a potential increase to meet the budget. This is collected in addition to the Council Tax by Newcastle under Lyme Borough Council. This year (2019/20) it is £18.32p per year (£0.35p per week) based on a Band D Council tax property. This was a decrease of £0.60p per year, from £18.92 in 2018/19, as the funding for Crossing Patrol assistants was no longer required. Next year (2020/21) there could be a 5% increase applied, which could see it rise by £0.92p per year (£19.24 per year/£0.37p per week) based on a Band D Council tax property.

Below is an example of some of the activities that will be achieved this year:

- Miners Wheel interpretation board (by the Country Park)
- Restoring the Mining Tribute (Heritage lottery fund) and a series of linked community events
- Hot spot clean ups eg litter picking, removal of vegetation, cutting back hedges, cleaning road and street signs, painting equipment
- Grants for free school uniform and school parking signs
- A village Christmas party, two Christmas trees and associated celebrations
- Hanging baskets at the village shops
- Two kissing gates for the Mineral Line and improved fencing
- Parish owned grit bin refills
- Newsletters delivered to all properties
